0145 BOARD MEMBER RESIGNATION AND REMOVAL

The membership of a Board of Education member shall terminate immediately upon:

- The cessation of the member's bona fide residency in the school district the member represents_ (N.J.S.A. 18A:12-2.2); or
- 2. The member's election or appointment to a governing body of South Orange or Maplewood; or
- 3. The member's disqualification from voting pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:4-1; or

3.<u>4.</u>

- 4.—<u>The member falsely affirms or declares that they are not disqualified as a voter pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:4-1 or that they are not disqualified from membership on the Board due to conviction of a crime or offense listed in N.J.S.A. 18A:12-1; or The member's conviction for false swearing for having falsely affirmed or declared that he or she is qualified to vote; or</u>
- 5. The removal of the member by the Commissioner of Education.
- 5.6. Recall of a Board member pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:27A-1 et seg.

A member who fails to attend three consecutive regular meetings of the Board without good cause may be removed from office on the affirmative votes of six of the remaining Board members, provided that:

- 1. The member's removal was proposed at the immediately previous Board meeting; and
- Notice of the proposed removal was given to the affected member at least twenty fourforty-eight hours in advance of the meeting at which the vote will be taken.

The Board will use best efforts to accommodate all Board members when scheduling an emergency or special meeting.
