BYLAWS 0132/page 1 of 1 Executive Authority

0132 EXECUTIVE AUTHORITY

The Board of Education shall exercise its executive power in part by the appointment of a Superintendent as Chief School Administrator, who shall enforce the statutes of the State of New Jersey, rules of the State Board of Education, and policies of this Board.

The Superintendent shall prepare regulations for the administration of the school district that are consistent with statutes or rules of the State Board of Education and <u>are dictated by the policies of this</u> conform to the intent of Board policy. Administrative regulations shall be binding upon the employees of this district and the <u>pupils students</u> of this school district these schools when issued by the Superintendent and shall be provided to the Board for the information of Board members except where Board approval is required by law. The Board reserves the right to revise an administrative regulation proposed by the Superintendent provided the revision is consistent with policy, statute, administrative code, or any other applicable law or collective bargaining agreement. Any administrative regulation that requires Board approval shall be Board-approved prior to promulgation. members shall be notified when new regulations are promulgated.

The Superintendent <u>shall be delegated the authority</u> is <u>authorized</u> to take necessary action in circumstances not governed by Board policy and shall report any such action to the Board at the first Board meeting following the action.

The Superintendent shall <u>have a seat on serve as an ex-officio member of</u> the Board and shall <u>have the right to speak on all matters at meetings of the Board, but shall have no vote. be encouraged to</u> participate in its discussions.
