## 0152 BOARD OFFICERS

The Board of Education shall organize at its first regular meeting by electing one of its members as President,-and two additional members as Vice Presidents. another member as Finst Viee President,. and another member as Seeond Viee President.

Any Board member may place a member's name in nomination for Board President and Vice Presidents; (ineluding their own); a second on the nomination is not required.as leng as the member-agrees to-serve in that role. Election for each office will be conducted by roll eall a vote when the nominations for that office are closed. The-eandidatereeeiving a majority vote of the members of the Beard present and constituting a quorumwill be elected to office.

Select Option 1 or 2 below

## Option-1-Written Paper Ballot

Voting shall take place by written ballot after neminations are closed for each position, President and Viee President. Eaeh Board member will be provided a paper ballot after nominations are elosed for each position. Each Board member shall right the name of one Board member they wish to vote for on the paper ballot. Each Board member must print and sign their name on their paper ballot. The ballots shall be read aloud by the Board Secretary identifying the Board member and their vote.

## Option 2- Verbal Roll Call Vote

Voting shall take place by verbal roll call vote after nominations are closed. When more than one person has been nominated for a single position, the Board will vote on candidates in the order in which they were nominated. In the event no eandidate reeeivesa majority vote of the members of the Board present and constituting a quorum, the proeedure shall eontinue until someone reeeives a majority vote.

Select Option 1 or 2 below

## Option 1- Elect Officers With a Majority Vote of all the Board Members Present

The person with the majority vote of the members of the Board present and constituting a quorum shall be elected. In the event no candidate receives a majority vote of the Board members present and constituting a quorum, the procedure shall be repeated until
someone receives a majority vote of those Board members present and constituting a quorum.

Option 2-Eleet Offieers With a Majority of all the Members of the Board
The person with the majority vote of all the members of the Board shall be elected. In the event no candidate reecives a majority vote of all of the members of the Board, the proeedure shall be repeated until someone reeeives a majority vote of all members of the Board.

Officers shall serve for one year and until their respective successors are elected and shall qualify, but if the Board shall fail to hold the organization meeting or to elect Board officers as prescribed by N.J.S.A. 18A:15-1, the Executive County Superintendent shall appoint from among the members of the Board a President and/or Vice-President(s).

A President or Vice-President who refuses to perform a duty imposed upon them by law may be removed by a majority vote of all the members of the Board. President or VieePresident by law may be remeved frem their offiee by a majority vote-of the full Beard. In the event the office of President or Vice-President shall become vacant the Board shall, within thirty days thereafter, fill the vacancy for the unexpired term. If the Board fails to fill the vacancy within such time, the Executive County Superintendent shall fill the vacancy for the unexpired term.
