- 65. A member to serve as delegate to the New Jersey School Boards Association, N.J.S.A. 18A:6-46;
- 76. An attendance officer,—N.J.S.A. 18A:38-32;
- 27. A Treasurer of School Moneys, N.J.S.A. 18A:17-31;
- Attorneys as needed;
- 98. A member to serve as delegate to the Essex County School Boards Association;

## 89. Attorneys as needed;

- 10. A member to serve as delegate to the Essex County Educational Services Commission;
- 11. Members to serve on Standing Committees of the Board;
- 12. Delegates to other associations as shall be determined annually by the Board of Education; and
