The district's Library/Media Centers exist to provide the materials and resources and technology necessary to accomplish the goals and objectives of the school system.

The Board of Education directs the Superintendent to develop regulations that will ensure the ability of the district's Library/Media Centers:

- 1.—To provide a comprehensive collection of instructional materials selected in compliance with basic-written selection principles, and to provide maximum accessibility to these materials.—
- 2.—To provide materials and instruction that will support that curriculum, taking into consideration the individual's needs, interests, abilities, backgrounds, and maturity levels of the students served.
- 3. To provide materials and instruction for teachers and students that will encourage growth inknowledge, and that will develop literary, cultural and aesthetic appreciation, and ethical standards.
- 4.—To provide materials that reflect the ideas and beliefs of religious, social, political, historical, and ethnic groups and their contribution to the American and world heritage and culture, thereby enabling students to develop an intellectual integrity in forming judgments.
- 5.—To provide qualified professional personnel to serve teachers and students.
- 6.—To provide necessary access, space and personnel to implement such a program.
