3233 POLITICAL ACTIVITIES

The Board of Education recognizes and encourages the right of all citizens, including teaching staff members, to engage in political activity. <u>However, t</u>The Board prohibits the use of school <u>premises grounds</u> and school time, <u>however</u>, for <u>partisan political purposes</u>.

The Board establishes the following guidelines to govern teaching staff members in their political activities:

- 1. A teaching staff member shall not engage in political activity on school premises unless permitted in accordance with Board Policy No. 7510 Use of School Facilities and/or applicable Federal and State laws;
- A teaching staff member shall not post or display political circulars or petitions on school <u>premises_grounds</u> nor distribute such circulars or petitions to students nor solicit campaign funds or campaign workers on school <u>premises_grounds</u>;
- A teaching staff member shall not display any material that would tend to promote any candidate for office on an election day in aon school facility grounds that is are used as a polling place.
- 4. A teaching staff member shall not engage in any activity in the presence of students manner, including but not limited to the wearing of buttons, display or promote a position of a collective bargaining issue or political issue while in the presence of students on school premises grounds, which is intended and/or designed to promote, further or assert a position(s) on labor relations issuesor during school sponsored events or activities.

<u>In accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:6-8.1.</u>, a teaching A certificated staff member employed by this district who is a member of the Senate or General Assembly of the State of New Jersey shall be entitled to time off from school district duties, without loss of pay, during the periods of <a href="https://historycommons.org/historycommons

<u>In accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:6-8.2.</u>, a teaching A certificated staff member employed by this district who is a member of the Board of <u>County Commissioners Chosen Freeholders</u> of any county of New Jersey shall be entitled to time off from <u>his/her-the teaching staff member's</u> duties, without pay, during the periods of <u>his/her-the teaching staff member's</u> attendance at regular or special meetings of the Board <u>of County Commissioners</u> and of any committee thereof and at such other times as <u>he/shethe teaching staff member</u>

shall be engaged in performing the necessary functions and duties of his/herthe.ceaching.staff.member's office as a member of the Board of County Commissioners.

No other teaching staff member who holds elective or appointive office is so entitled to time off, except as such time off may be provided for by Board policy or negotiated agreement.

The provisions of this <u>P</u>policy do not apply to the discussion and study of politics and political issues appropriate to the curriculum, the conduct of student elections, or the conduct of employee representative elections <u>except as proscribed by Board policy</u>.

Nothing in this Policy shall be interpreted to impose a burden on the constitutionally protected speech or conduct of a teaching staff member or a student.
