5860 SAFETY PATROL

The Board of Education recognizes the value of a school safety patrol as a means of preventing accidents, instructing <u>pupils students</u> in good habits, and providing opportunities for leadership training.

The Board authorizes the establishment of a school safety patrol of <u>pupils students</u> at the elementary and <u>where appropriate at the middle school level</u>. Student safety patrols shall be under the direction of a faculty advisor.

All eligible <u>pupils_students_</u>may apply for appointment to the safety patrol. <u>No student may serve without</u> the written consent of his/her parent(s) or legal guardian(s). All applicants must acknowledge the possible hazards of safety patrol duty and agree that in the case of injury no liability will be attached to the Board or to any employee of this Board. Selection among applicants will be made on the basis of the applicant's demonstrated sense of responsibility, good citizenship, leadership capacity, maturity, and academic proficiency. Members of the safety patrol must attend a training program before they may assume duties. No pupil may serve without the written consent of his or her parent or legal guardianSafety patrol members shall serve for one school year. A member may be removed from the safety patrol for violation of school rules or failure to maintain the high standard of conduct expected of school safety patrol members.

Members of the school safety patrol may be assigned to control and direct <u>pupil-student</u> traffic on school <u>premisesgrounds</u>, <u>on school buses</u>, <u>and</u> on sidewalks and paths adjacent to a street or roadway <u>and</u> <u>across streets and roadways</u>. The school safety patrol shall discourage other students from crossing <u>public streets and roadways at points other than at regular crossings</u>, and shall direct students not to cross public streets and roadways at times when the presence of traffic would render such crossings unsafe. No school safety patrol member shall be permitted to direct or place himself or herself in the path of vehicular traffic.

All <u>pupils students</u> shall be instructed to respect the authority of school safety patrol members in the performance of their duties.

No liability shall attach to the Board or any person holding office, position or employment under the board, by virtue of the organization, maintenance or operation of a school safety patrol organized, maintained, and operated under authority of N.J.S.A. 18A:42-1.
