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## 8110 ATTENDANCE AREAS

This policy has been abolished. See Policy 5120.

The Board shall determine the school attendance areas of the district to determine the assignment of pupils to school in accordance with Policy No. 5120.

Students shall be required to attend the school in the attendance area in which they reside, with the following exceptions:

- 1. Special Services students;
- 2. Children who move from one attendance area to another during the year;
- 3. and those exceptions as enumerated in Policy 5124;
- At the discretion of the administration when it appears evident that attendance at another school is in the best interest of a student and/or the school;
- 5. When attendance areas result in large numbers of children in certain classes at one school and smaller numbers of children in the same classes at another school, the administration may balance the classes in size by transferral of students. The students so transferred will be those who live nearest the less crowded school:

The Superintendent shall annually review existing attendance areas and recommend to the Board such changes as may be justified by considerations of safe pupil transportation and travel; convenience of access to the schools; financial and administrative efficiency, the effectiveness of the instructional program, and a wholesome and educationally sound balance of pupil populations.
