8451 CONTROL OF COMMUNICABLE DISEASE

The Board of Education recognizes that control of the spread of communicable disease is essential to the well-being of the school community and to the efficient operation of the schools.

The Board ~~shall~~will be bound by the statutes and by rules of the State Board of Education for the exclusion and readmission of ~~pupil~~students who have contracted a communicable disease and of teachers and ~~pupils~~students who have been exposed to a communicable disease and for the instruction of teachers in health and the prevention of disease. The Board ~~shall~~will comply with regulations of the New Jersey Department of Health and the Essex County Board of Health governing the prevention, control, and reporting of communicable disease.

The teacher may exclude from the classroom and the Principal may exclude from the school building any ~~pupil~~student who appears to be ill or has been exposed to a communicable disease. A ~~pupil~~student may be isolated in school to await the arrival of or instructions from an adult member of ~~his or her~~the student's family. If the school medical inspector or the school nurse is present in the building, ~~his or her~~that professional's recommendation ~~shall~~will be sought before any such exclusion or isolation is ordered.

Any ~~pupil~~student retained at home or excluded from school by reason of having or being suspected of having a communicable disease ~~shall~~will not be readmitted to ~~his or her~~the student's classroom until ~~he or she~~the student presents written evidence of being free of communicable disease. That evidence may be supplied by the school medical inspector or another qualified physician who has examined the ~~pupil~~student.

Any ~~pupil~~student or adult who has weeping skin lesions that cannot be covered ~~shall~~will be excluded from school.

The Superintendent ~~or his/her designee shall~~will develop procedures for the control of communicable disease that include the instruction of teaching staff members in the detection of disease and measures for its prevention and control; the removal from school premises to the care of a responsible adult for ~~pupil~~students identified and excluded in accordance with this policy; the preparation of standards for the readmission of ~~pupils~~students who have recovered from communicable disease; the provision of appropriate home instruction to excluded ~~pupil~~students in accordance with law; and the filing of reports as required by law.
