8500 FOOD SERVICES

The Superintendent shall insure that wholesome, nutritious lunches are available.

The Board shall provide food service facilities for the consumption of food on school premises.

The district shall participate in the Federal School Lunch Program.

The Food Service Program shall be operated on a nonprofit basis. All moneys derived from the operation, maintenance, or sponsorship of the food service facilities shall be deposited in the Food Service Account. A periodic review of the food service account shall be made by the Superintendent or his/her designee. Any surplus funds shall be used to reduce the cost of the service to pupils or to purchase cafeteria equipment.

The Superintendent or his/her designee shall insure the maintenance of sanitary, neat premises, free from fire and health hazards, for the preparation and consumption of food and the safekeeping and storage of food and food equipment in strict compliance with regulations of the New Jersey State Department of Health.
