Progress Targets

- NJDOE replaced Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) with new Progress Targets based on a student growth model for academic achievement. (ESEA Waiver)
- SOMSD adopted District Goals for 2012-13 that include a description of expectations for student growth on state assessments using this model. (Goal 1, Objective A, Indicator 2)

Information & Requirements

- Preliminary Progress Target data was released to districts in October 2012, based on spring 2012 assessment data.
- Information regarding schools that did not meet progress targets was released to districts mid-February 2013.
- Districts were required to adopt and submit action plans designed to support student learning in schools that did not meet progress targets by March 1, 2013.
- SOMSD Board approved action plans for 3 schools at the Board of Education public session held on February 25th, submitted plans to the County Superintendent's Office, and posted these documents to the district website as required.

Designations

- NJDOE placed designations on schools across the state: Priority, Focus, Reward, not meeting Progress Targets. Some schools received no designation.
- Priority, & Focus schools, along with those not meeting Progress Targets were required to create action plans specific to areas of need.

NJDOE Designations

- Focus Schools Clinton Elementary, Maplewood Middle, and South Orange Middle Schools due to a large gap between performance of students in the highest and 2 lowest performing subgroups as defined by NJDOE. (3 year aggregate of data)
- Jefferson, South Mountain, and Tuscan Elementary Schools did not meet 1 or more Progress Targets. (spring 2012 data)
- Seth Boyden Elementary and Columbia High School met all Progress Targets.
- Marshall School does not serve students in grades tested by NJDOE
