BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the 2018-19 Budget includes adjustments for the use of banked cap, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-10.3(b), in the amount of \$147,754 and current health care adjustments in the amount of \$326,831.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the South Orange and Maplewood Board of Education authorizes the Business Administrator to submit the 2018-2019 Preliminary Budget to the County Superintendent for review and approval.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the South Orange and Maplewood Board of Education, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.3(a), establishes a maximum travel expenditure for the 2018-2019 school year not to exceed the amount of \$150,000.

The 2018-2019 Preliminary Budget is submitted to the County Superintendent for his approval for the official advertisement of the budget statement. The Public Hearing to approve the budget is scheduled for Monday, April 30, 2018.

SUBJECT: APPROVE USE OF BANKED CAP FOR THE 2018-2019 BUDGET

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the South Orange and Maplewood Board of Education, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-10.3(b)2, approves the use of \$147,754 banked cap (2015-16 unused adjustment) to meet budgetary requirements for the 2018-19 school year. The funds are needed for teaching staff to meet the increasing enrollment needs of the district. The district has fully exhausted all eligible statutory spending authority and must increase the base budget in the amount of \$147,754 for the purpose of maintaining the academic program in compliance with the state and local academic goals. The additional staffing is necessary for the 2018-19 operating budget and this need must be completed by June 2019 and cannot be deferred or incrementally completed over a longer period of time.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

N.J.S.A. 18A:7F-39 was amended in 2010, effective beginning in 2011-12, to allow a school district that has not been granted approval to exceed the tax levy cap by a separate proposal to "bank" the unused tax levy for use in any of the next three succeeding budget years. In accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:3A-10.3(b) a district can request the use of "banked cap" only after it has fully exhausted all eligible statutory spending authority in the budget year. Banked cap is available from 2015-16 (\$147,754). The banked cap from the earliest pre-budget year must be used first.
