**SUBJECT: SOUTH ORANGE–MAPLEWOOD BOARD OF EDUCATION
RESOLUTION UPHOLDING STUDENT REMOVAL FOR
NON–RESIDENCY**

WHEREAS, the South Orange–Maplewood Board of Education (“Board”) is responsible for ensuring that students attending schools within the district are bona fide residents entitled to a free public education pursuant to applicable New Jersey statutes and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the district conducted a residency review concerning a Student ID# 7194318756 currently enrolled in the South Orange–Maplewood School District; and

WHEREAS, the residency review included an examination of documentation, records, and any information provided by the Student’s parent(s)/guardian(s); and

WHEREAS, based upon the information gathered, the administration determined that the Student is not domiciled within the geographic boundaries of the South Orange–Maplewood School District and is therefore not entitled to continued enrollment without payment of tuition; and

WHEREAS, a residency hearing was held on March 10, 2026 before a committee of the Board, during which the parent(s)/guardian(s) were provided an opportunity to present information and respond to the district’s determination; and

WHEREAS, upon consideration of the information presented at the March 10th hearing, as well as all submitted materials and relevant information, the Board finds that the determination of non–residency was made in accordance with applicable law and district policy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the South Orange–Maplewood Board of Education hereby upholds the administration’s determination that the Student is not a resident of the district; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Student shall be removed from enrollment in the South Orange–Maplewood School District effective immediately, or on a date determined appropriate by the Superintendent, unless tuition arrangements are made in accordance with district policy; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the parent(s)/guardian(s) shall be responsible for any tuition assessed for the period of ineligible attendance, consistent with New Jersey law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Superintendent or designee is authorized to take all necessary actions to implement this resolution.
