Re: Evaluation of Summer Programs 2013
Attached please find a summary of data regarding District Summer Programs offered between June and August, 2013. District programs served students from Kindergarten to Grade 12 in order to support, remediate, and accelerate student learning and levels of achievement.

Students experienced a wide range of content, delivered in innovative, and dynamic ways by approximately 84 members of the district teaching staff. Approximately 308 elementary, and 235 middle school students participated in a variety of courses designed to meet their needs. In addition, 204 high school students participated in approximately 22 individual courses offered at the high school level, for the purpose of credit recovery 47 students participated in the Bridge to Success program, and another 122 participated in academic enrichment offerings. It should be noted that many of these high school students participated in more than one course. The total seat count for CHS students was 490 .

386 of the 894 students enrolled in 2013 summer programming qualify for Free or Reduced Lunch, and 454 seats for courses offered during the summer months were filled by students who have IEPs. 317 of our students with IEPs participated in programming designed and implemented by the Department of Pupil Services. Many other students with IEPs participated in one or more of the general program offerings.

The Department of Curriculum \& Instruction will be monitoring the progress of all students who participated in the 2013 summer programs throughout the year in order to determine the effectiveness of services provided.
